1. Research the life of your Patron Saint and describe what you have learned. Write in the back when needed or add pages to this report.

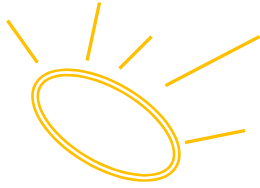
2. Explain what aspects of his/her life or virtues you feel you can relate to and will be able to emulate.
